We want to share our plan for the 2021-2022 school year at the Pelham School District.

ALL LUNCH MEALS MUST BE PRE-ORDERED BY 8 AM ON THE DAY YOU OR YOUR STUDENT WILL BE RECEIVING THE MEAL.

Breakfast meals do not need to be pre-ordered.

Preordering for Lunch Meals and Menus: Families, students and/or staff must pre-order lunch meals using the system available at <https://pelhamsd.nutrislice.com/menu/menus-eula>.

Lunch Meals can be pre-ordered up to 10 school days ahead of time.

You will select the school in which your student/s are located on the main page. These menus are specific to each school. Once you are in the location for your student, you will go to the day for which you would like to order and click on the meals (lunch) you will then see a blue section that says add to cart. Once you are ready to check out you will need to create an account if you have not already done so. Below are the details specific to each school for online ordering and meal times.

Pelham Elementary School:

Breakfast: 8:30-9:15- Breakfast is a grab-and-go style program from the cafe. There will be hot and cold breakfast options for your students to take and bring back to their classroom with them. They do NOT need to pre-order Breakfast.

Lunch: Served in the Cafeteria. By filling out the details in your student's profile in the online ordering system, you will help us to safely and accurately make sure that each student who orders will receive a meal. They are as follows:

1st Lunch- GRADE 1: 11:00-11:30

2nd Lunch GRADE 2: 11:30-12:00

3th Lunch GRADE 3: 12:00-12:30

4th lunch GRADE 4: 12:30-1:00

5th lunch GRADE 5: 1:00-1:30

Pelham Memorial School:

Breakfast: 7:25-7:50- Breakfast is a grab-and-go style program. There will be carts with breakfast choices for your student to visit on the way into the school building and they will bring their selected breakfast to their advisory. Students do NOT need to pre-order Breakfast.

Lunch is served in the Cafeteria. By filling out the details in your student's profile in the online ordering system, you will help us to safely and accurately make sure that each student who orders will receive a meal. They are as follows:

6th Grade: 10:55-11:25

7th Grade: 11:30-12:00

8th Grade: 12:00-12:30

Pelham High School:

Breakfast: 7:25-8:00 Breakfast is a grab-and-go style program in the cafeteria. Students do NOT need to pre-order Breakfast.

Lunch is served in the Cafeteria. By filling out the details in your student's profile in the online ordering system, you will help us to safely and accurately make sure that each student who orders will receive a meal. They are as follows:

Third Block:

Lunch A: 11:25-11:48

Lunch B: 12:13-12:36

Lunch C: 12:42-1:05

THERE WILL BE NO REMOTE MEAL PICK UP THIS YEAR.

Meals are at no cost until further notice. When the USDA meal waiver runs out those who have a free or reduced application on file will remain eligible for the Free and Reduced Meal Program. As we receive additional funding and can offer additional benefits to qualified families, we encourage you to complete a Free and Reduced Application for eligible families.
