Highlights

CROP's mission is to grow citizens who contribute positively to their communities.

We provide academic support and enrichment, youth development activities, and parent involvement events in a safe and supportive environment after school and during the summer.

Highlights from our Year-End Evaluation:

1330 students attended CROP at some point during the 2017-2018 year at one of the fourteen CROP sites

88% of CROP students reported that they got to do things in CROP that they couldn't do anywhere else

93% of students felt that they were better at "standing up for what I believe in" because they attended CROP

62% of students who needed to improve showed increased levels of school engagement and academic commitment as shown by class participation and homework completion

51% of CROP students who have a history of discipline problems showed an increase in classroom attentiveness while 45% showed improvement in classroom behavior

Last school year, 621 parents participated in CROP events and field trips such as cooking workshops, parent orientations, trips to aquariums and museums, and "Math and Movement" nights

100% of parents reported that they believe CROP provides a safe and supportive environment for their child
