This month our students will participate in the following:

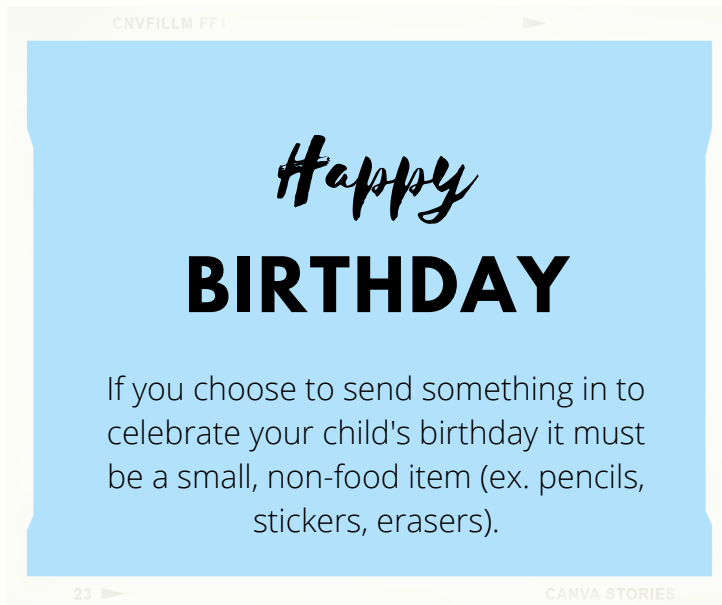
- PreK: Early Learning Assessment (ELA)
- Kindergarten: Kindergarten Readiness Assessment (KRA)
- K - 5th Grade: iReady Reading and Math Diagnostics

These tests help us determine where students are currently performing and plan our instruction to meet each student's needs. These tests do not factor into a student's grades. The results of these assessments will be shared with families. Please encourage your child to always do their best.
