End of Year Assessments

Beginning this month our students will participate in the following:

PreK:Early Learning Assessment (ELA)K - 5th Grade:iReady Reading and Math Diagnostics3rd - 5th Grade:Ohio State Tests in English Language Arts, Math, and Science (Grade 5 ONLY)

These assessments help us determine how much our students have grown this school year. The Ohio State Tests also help us determine each student's mastery of grade level standards. These tests do not factor into a student's grades. They are important assessments though, and we ask that you please encourage your child to always do their best.
