# SAFETY AND ATTENDANCE

Dear Families,

Safety and maximizing instructional time are our priorities at Washington Elementary School. We need your help making sure our students are safe at arrival and dismissal and are present for every minute of instruction.

- Doors open at 8:00a.m. Students who arrive after 8:15a.m. are tardy.
- Dismissal is at 1:45pm for PreK and 2:30p.m. for our K-5th graders. Please limit early dismissals.
- Changes to your child's dismissal routine must be shared with the office by 1:00p.m.
- Absences must be reported to the office by 9:00a.m.
- Our staff and Safety Patrol are there to remind everyone of the following:
  - Only cross at crosswalks. Do not obstruct crosswalks with your car.
  - Keep the flow of traffic moving by pulling up as far as you can and only stopping in the lane closest to the building. Please do not park in or near the bus lane on the side of the building.
  - Be aware of your surroundings. Watch for students, families and other cars.

We are partners in making sure that our students arrive on time and are dismissed safely. Remember every minute matters. Even a few minutes of missed instruction has an impact.
