#### Be ready for these changes to the FAFSA....

-The FAFSA will not open until December 2023 (Be Ready)
-There is no more EFC. FAFSA will now use a Student Aid Index.
-Everyone needs an FSA ID to complete the FAFSA.
-Students can pick their contributor.
-Tax information is linked once you give consent through FAFSA.
-The new FAFSA will be easier to complete.
-No more discount for multiple students in college.
