

SAFETY AND ATTENDANCE

Dear Families.

Safety and maximizing instructional time are our priorities at Washington Elementary School. We need your help making sure our students are safe at arrival and dismissal and are present for every minute of instruction.

- Doors open at 8:00a.m. Students who arrive after 8:15a.m. are tardy.
- Dismissal is at 2:30p.m. Please limit early dismissals. Changes to your child's dismissal routine must be shared with the office by 1:00p.m.
- Absences must be reported to the office by 9:00a m
- Our staff and Safety Patrol are there to remind everyone of the following:
 - Only cross at crosswalks. Do not obstruct crosswalks with your car.
 - Keep the flow of traffic moving by pulling up as far as you can and only stopping in the lane closest to the building.
 - Be aware of your surroundings. Watch for students, families and other cars.

We are partners in making sure that our students arrive on time and are dismissed safely. Remember every minute matters. Even a few minutes of missed instruction has an impact. If you have any questions please contact the office at 440-830-4210.

Third Grade Reading Guarantee

Ohio's Third Grade Reading Guarantee is a program to identify students from kindergarten through grade 3 who are behind in reading. Washington provides help and support to make sure students are on track for reading success by the end of third grade.

Third grade students must meet certain criteria to be promoted to fourth grade. Students in third grade get multiple opportunities to meet this criteria. **The week of Oct. 18th 3rd grade students will take the Fall Ohio State Test (OST) in English Language Arts (ELA).** More information regarding the Third Grade Reading Guarantee can be found here.
