Dear Families,

Our Titan character trait for December is Academic Growth or Growth Mindset. Growth Mindset is the belief that your brain can grow and you can learn many new things. We foster this in many ways at school. We praise students for hard work and perseverance. We encourage students to take risks and try new things. We set goals with students and help them determine the steps they can take to accomplish those goals.

Here are some simple ways you can foster Growth Mindset at home:

- Have conversations about learning. Ask your child, "What did you learn today?" or "What did you try hard at today?"
- Emphasize growth and progress. They do not need to be THE best; they just need to be THEIR best!
