Call to Order

Mr. Bills called the meeting to order at 6:36pm

Purpose – Purpose of the Meeting is for the approval of additional devices for students and staff.

Mr. Nelson explained that there was already \$150K earmarked for new devices for the 2023-2024 school year for new students. Typically, the school would pay \$400 per device. The current cost is closer to \$250 per device, saving the school over \$100k on devices. The school would also like to secure devices for the 2024-2025 school year because of the amount of savings. This proposed lease agreement would cover 5th grade and 9th grade supplies (4-year life cycle on the devices), as well as cover the increase in ADM. This savings outweighs interest that will be paid on lease agreement – 1 annual payment over the next 3 years 1-2% APR. The school is seeking board approval to move forward on this opportunity. Since \$150K has already been budgeted, this could free up some funds within the current budget.

• Mr. Ward made a motion, seconded by Mr. Reid to procure over 1250 Chromebook devices at a cost of up to \$325K with a 3-year lease. Vote taken by roll call. All in favor. None opposed. Motion Carried.
