2. SHOW COMPETENCY*

- **End-of-Course Exams (AIR Tests)**

- Students will take the following EOCEs: Algebra I, Bio, English II, Geometry, US History, Gov.
- Students need to earn a passing score of 684 on both the English II and Algebra I EOCE
- Students who do not pass the test(s) will be offered additional support and must retake the test. If the testing requirements are not met, there are 3 additional ways to show competency:
 - 1. Demonstrate 2 Career Focused Activities*
 - 2. Enlist in the military*
 - 3. Complete College Course work through the College Credit Plus Program*

3. SHOW READINESS*

4. COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS
