2026-2027

1. Complete name and telephone information.
2. Circle the course number in each required academic area and elective courses.
 - a. **Teacher recommendation (initials)** are required for all academics and any elective with a signature line next to it.
3. Sophomores must take credits in each of the following academic areas:
 - 1 credit English
 - 1 credit Math
 - 1 credit Science
 - 1 credit Social Studies
 - $\frac{1}{4}$ credit Physical Education –or–
PE Waiver
 - 0.5 Financial Literacy
 - 1 - 1.5 Elective credit
4. Students and parents/guardians **must sign** the Course Request Form.
5. All students must be registered for at least 6 classes each semester.
7. Schedules may be changed by contacting your Mrs. Seward **before the first day of class. Schedule changes after the start of class are not permitted.**

Athletic Eligibility Note: Students must be passing five courses each semester. Physical Education is .25 credit and does not apply toward eligibility. Please be aware of grades in order to remain eligible to participate in athletic programs.
