### Necessary Classroom Supplies:

- Water Bottle (labeled with your child's name)
- 2 composition notebooks (NOT Spiral-bound) (color / design doesn't matter)
- 3 Spiral Bound Notebooks: Yellow, Green and Blue (Colors important for organization)
- 1 zipper pouch or pencil box for writing utensils.  
**\*Please no large pencil boxes as they take up valuable space.**
- 6 Sturdy folders with Pockets  
Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue and Purple  
(Colors important for organization by subject–  
Please don't label at home, we will label with the kids)
- Highlighters - Pink, Orange, Yellow, Green and Blue  
(Colors important for annotating)
- Colored pencils - 1 Pack (primary colors)
- 1 pair sharp scissors
- 4 pink erasers (not pencil top)
- Glue Sticks x4
- Headphones or Earbuds
- Pencils x24
- 4 Black Skinny Dry Erase Markers & Clean old sock for eraser
- 3 packs of 3x3 Sticky Notes
