I am excited to share that Montrose High School is enrolled in Mobile Health's (CDE / CDPHE vendor), free, voluntary, statewide COVID-19 school testing program for the 2021-22 school year. This is a critical step to keeping our students and staff healthy and allows us to continue in-person learning. The safety of our students and educators is our top priority.

All students under 18 **must** obtain parental/guardian consent to participate in this voluntary program. Students and staff who participate in this program will be exempt from quarantining as long as they have weekly negative results and are asymptomatic. This program begins on Friday, November 12 with testing personnel on site from 7 am until 3:30 pm.

The COVID-19 testing program is available to all students and staff, regardless of vaccination status. School testing will be implemented with the help of a state contractor.
