# Seniors ~ Graduation Practice

- **May 16th** - LAST DAY FOR SENIORS with SENIOR PICNIC mid-day
- 9-12 PM: Graduation Practice
- Upon returning from Grad Practice, as long as Senior Picnic was not canceled on Thursday, May 16, then students are permitted to go home. Any student who needs to ride the bus home, will need to stay until the end of the normal school day.
- If Senior Picnic was canceled on May 16 due to weather, then Senior Picnic will take place right after Graduation Practice at the high school on May 17.
- **ALL** fees must be paid, device turn in.
- **ALL** athletic uniforms turned-in if season(s) are completed

# Seniors ~ Expectations/Dates

- There are **NO sanctioned or approved “skip days”** as seniors end five full days before the rest of the District
- Avoid poor decisions that put yourself at-risk of unintended consequences:
  - Those who are 18 - think - adult rules
  - Safety concerns, “just a joke”, damage/destruction of property
  - Athletic consequences - coding, tournament-play is at jeopardy
  - Not walking at graduation
  - Unexcused absences = no grades or makeups
- YOUR “jokes” put the decisions of your privileges in someone else’s hands
- After the fact is when most say -” I wouldn’t have done that if I knew [blank] consequence would happen...”
