Strategies

- provide educational opportunities that cultivate intellectual and personal skills that allow students to have an impact on the community and world.
- ensure each student is actively engaged in their learning and demonstrates increasing responsibility toward becoming a self-directed learner by developing the *Portrait of a General* competencies.
- intentionally integrate the *Portrait of a General* competencies within the students' daily experiences.
- work collaboratively to implement strategies that will facilitate each student developing the *Portrait of a General* competencies.
- support each students' interests and aspirations and will work to make informed decisions about their future careers and the pathway to achieve their goals.



Goal 2: Curriculum & Instruction

All Generals will experience an innovative and engaging curriculum with instruction that is personalized, promotes creativity and application and provides real-world experiences that facilitate deeper learning.



Strategies

- provide professional development to all staff that is relevant to the District goals, differentiated to staff needs and applicable to students becoming future ready
- create a collaborative work group to develop a Personalized Student Learning Plan that will facilitate staff in providing engaging instructional strategies.
- choose curricular materials to utilize in the learning environment based on student-centered decisions.
- collaboratively establish and implement comprehensive academic and personalized skills that will facilitate students becoming future ready.
- develop a comprehensive course selection and curriculum that is relevant to foundational skills, embeds creativity, provides real-world experiences and contains applications for students to be future ready.



Goal 3: Community Engagement

Anthony Wayne Local Schools will engage in two-way communication and collaboration to promote community engagement and develop partnerships for the purpose of providing outstanding learning opportunities and to strengthen school and community pride.

Strategies

- seek input from all stakeholders about their desire for two-way communication and from this feedback, develop a Communication Action Plan.
- continue to find innovative ways to communicate with student, staff, parents and the community and will adapt as new communication tools and technologies emerge.
- develop consistency in communication and set communications expectations within the District.
- will be an active participant in promoting and supporting Generals Pride within the District and community.
- will work to create partnerships with area businesses in order to provide opportunities for students to be future ready.
- engage the community through active communications about the current and future financial and academic needs of the District.



Goal 4: Resources for Student Success

Anthony Wayne Local Schools will continue to work with the community to provide the necessary resources to ensure all Generals are future ready.

Strategies

- utilize financial and physical resources to support the personalized learning of each student that will allow each to be future ready.
- plan for and allocate funding to provide resources needed to deliver high quality, experiential learning opportunities for all students.
- engage stakeholders in collaborative efforts to secure resources to prepare students to be future ready.
- be good stewards of the residents' tax dollars by operating a strategically aligned and efficient budget that will be clearly communicated with the public.
- will budget in order to maintain the quality of our programs and facilities so they can support academics, arts, athletics and activities.
- will complete a facilities assessment to determine if the District is prepared to meet the current and future academic, athletic and extracurricular needs of students and staff
- create a new facilities master plan to include short, middle and long term building needs that is monitored and adapted as growth happens in the District.



Goal 5: Students and Staff Ready to Learn

All Anthony Wayne Local Schools students and staff will have access to personalized services to allow them, as Generals to be successful academically and grow personally in all that they pursue and do each and every day.



Strategies

- align building and department goals with the District goals and *Portrait of a General* competencies.

- partner with the community to provide a positive culture for the District for staff and students that will facilitate students' learning each day.
