Parents Right to Know Information

As a parent of a student at any elementary school within the Montrose County School District, you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teacher who instructs your child. This is a requirement for all school districts that receive Title I funding. Federal law allows you to request certain information about your student's classroom teacher. The law also requires that our school district give you this information in a timely manner upon request. Listed below is the information about which you have the right to ask for information regarding each of your student's classroom teachers.

- Whether the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) has licensed or endorsed your student's teacher for the grades and subjects taught.
- Whether CDE has decided that your student's teacher can teach in a classroom without being licensed or qualified under state regulations because of special circumstances.
- The teachers' college major; whether the teacher has any advanced degrees, and if so, the subject of the degrees.
- Whether any teachers' aides or similar paraeducators provide services to your child, and if they do, their qualifications.
