Shoutout to our Paris Middle School Greyhounds for their win on 8th Grade Night!



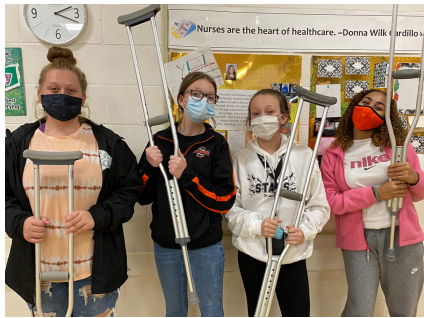
8th Grade Lunch
