

CYBER-BULLYING

What should we do when we see cyberbullying occur?

RESPONDING TO THE CYBER-BULLYING

You can stand up for the victim

by telling others what they are doing or saying is hurtful.

- Do so in a neutral or positive way.
- Say that you do not agree with the bully.
- Use positive comments about the victim.
- Do not engage in arguments, commenting wars, or act aggressively.

Talk to the victim

This will let the victim know that someone cares about him/her.

- If you know the victim, call him/her.
- Ask if the victim knows or has seen what is going on.
- If the victim has not, tell her/him not to log on, check her phone etc.
- If the victim has seen or does know about the bullying, offer support or advice.



Help save evidence

To report cyber-bullying the victim will need evidence to show what happened.

- First, ask the victim if he/she wants help keeping copies or notes, texts, emails, etc.
- Offer to save all of the information for him/her so does not have to look at it.

Encourage the victim to tell an adult

It is always best to find an adult and tell them what happened. Remember, this is not tattling.

- Tell her/him that you really think the victim should tell an adult.
- Offer to go with her/him.
- Offer to do the talking if she/he feels uncomfortable.

Remind the victim not to open it! Anything the victim doesn't see cannot hurt
