NEW START DATE

First day for Students will be Wednesday, August 26th

First day for Staff will be Monday, August 17th

First day for Preschool students is **Wednesday, September 2nd**

Paris Elementary: 7:35 am - 2:50 pm

Paris Middle and Paris High School: 8:15 am until 3:30 pm



INSTRUCTION

Students and families will have two options for this school year.



In-Person Learning - Every student, every day!

Paris Independent Schools are committed to opening our doors to in-person instruction each and every day. We do not intend to implement A/B schedules which would require students to attend on alternating days or weeks. We also plan to avoid half-day schedules.

Virtual Learning - Greyhound Academy

Parents and students may choose the Paris Greyhound Academy as a learning-at-home option. Chromebooks will be provided for students who choose in person and virtual learning

We will be contacting parents soon about whether they intend to send their students to school every day; OR if they prefer a virtual/distance learning option with the Paris Greyhound Academy.

SAFETY EXPECTATIONS

At minimum, Paris Schools will follow the Kentucky Department for Public Health and the Kentucky Department of Education safety expectations based upon the core measures to mitigate transmission.

These include:

- Social Distancing
- · Screening, School Exclusion & Contact Tracing
- Personal Protective Equipment, including Cloth Face Masks
- Sanitation, Environmental, and Industrial Factor
- Temperature Checks conducted each day for all students and staff
