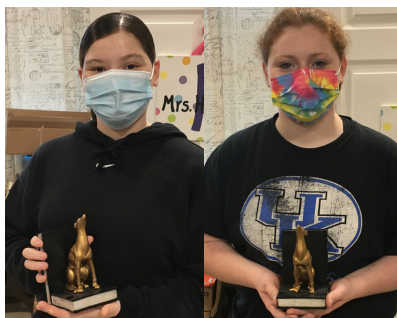


PPE Training at PHS!

A message from PHS Band Director Mr. Eric Masters:

"Unfortunately, COVID's impact over the past two years is still being felt. We have been dealing with several logistical shortfalls (for example, turkeys are in short supply this year and most providers are giving very big restrictions as to how many they can sell to one person or organization). Along with logistical issues we have to consider the rising number of COVID cases in Bourbon County and the low indication of attendance through pre-sale ticket numbers.

With all factors considered, after discussing with the coordinators for the turkey dinner, we have decided that the band would be better served focusing our resources on a future community meal.

As such, we are postponing the 2021 Turkey Dinner. Instead, we are working to repurpose the event for Spring 2022. We are eye-balling late March and will have more information in the ensuing weeks.

Again, it pains me to cancel the event this year. We love serving the community and we love the support you all have given us over the years. If you have already purchased pre-sale tickets we will be working to get in contact and give you a refund in the next week.
