Good Afternoon,

The Union Local School District has had three new cases of COVID. Two cases are in students at Union Local Elementary. Another case is in a student at Union Local Middle. Union Local District has seven active cases of COVID at Union Local Elementary. Four active cases of COVID exist at Union Local Middle School. Union Local High School has three active cases. Families are asked to report any positive cases of COVID within their child to their respective child's school nurse. Also, if the child may have been considered a close contact of someone with a positive case this should be reported to the school nurse.

The district is asking that families continue to complete daily at home monitoring of children prior to them coming to school. It is of the utmost importance that these steps be completed.
