Currently, the Union Local School District has 10 cases of COVID in the district. The high school has 3 cases (One new case reported yesterday) Union Local Middle School has 3 cases. Union Local Elementary School has 3 cases all in students. There is one case of COVID in a staff member who supervises extracurricular activities.

Families are asked to report any positive cases of COVID within their child to their respective child's school nurse. They can be accessed by the building numbers or by calling Union Local Elementary number is 740-526-6832 or the Union Local Middle and High School number is 740-526-1409.

In addition to the above information, the district is asking families to complete daily at home monitoring of children prior to them coming to school. It is of the utmost importance that these steps be completed
