Good Afternoon,

The Union Local School District will be operating on a hybrid schedule at 50% capacity beginning the week of January 11. The schedule for this week includes:

- Monday: No students. Staff only will work on campus.
- Tuesday and Wednesday Group A Students will attend school on campus.
- Thursday and Friday Group B students will attend school on campus.

Currently, the Union Local School District has 9 cases of COVID in the district. The high school has 2 cases. Union Local Middle School has 3 cases. Union Local Elementary School has 3 cases all in students. There is one case of COVID in a staff member who supervises extracurricular activities.

Families are urged to contact the district hotlines to report positive cases or if there are questions in regards to close contacts or necessities to quarantine. The Union Local Elementary number is 740-526-6832. The Union Local Middle and High School number is 740-526-1409.

In addition to the above information, the district is asking families to complete daily at home monitoring of children prior to them coming to school. It is of the utmost importance that these steps be completed
