Good Afternoon,

The Union Local School District has five new confirmed cases of COVID. One case at Union Local High School involved a student who had not been at school due to quarantine. Three cases at Union Local Middle School, who had not been at school due to quarantine. Union Local Elementary School has one new case in a student, who had not been at school due to quarantine. Union Local District has thirteen active cases of COVID at Union Local Elementary. Ten active cases of COVID exist at Union Local Middle School. Union Local High School has two active cases.

Families are asked to report any positive cases of COVID within their child to their respective child's school nurse. Also, if the child may have been considered a close contact of someone with a positive case this should be reported to the school nurse.

The district is asking that families continue to complete daily at home monitoring of children prior to them coming to school. It is of the utmost importance that these steps be completed

___ Exposure to a positive COVID case

Families should not send a child to school if any of the above symptoms are present in a student. Families should seek guidance from their child's respective school in return to school protocol. This can be obtained by speaking with the building nurse.
