Good Morning,

The Union Local School District has had six new cases of COVID. There are two reported cases in each building.

Families are asked to report any positive cases of COVID within their child to their respective child's school nurse. Also, if the child may have been considered a close contact of someone with a positive case this should be reported to the school nurse.

The district is asking that families continue to complete daily at home monitoring of children prior to them coming to school. It is of the utmost importance that these steps be completed.

Morning Temperature: _____

Fever or Chills

Headache

Cough

Shortness of Breath or Difficulty Breathing

Fatigue

Muscle or Body Aches

New loss of taste or smell

Sore Throat

Congestion or runny nose

Nausea or vomiting

Diarrhea

Exposure to a positive COVID case

Families should not send a child to school if any of the above symptoms are present in a student. Families should seek guidance from their child's respective school in return to school protocol. This can be obtained by speaking with the building nurse.
