Good Afternoon,

The Union Local School District thirty two reported cases of COVID. There are sixteen reported cases at Union Local High School and five reported cases in the Union Local Middle School. Union Local Elementary School has eleven reported cases.

Families are asked to report any positive cases of COVID within their child to their respective child's school nurse. Also, if the child may have been considered a close contact of someone with a positive case this should be reported to the school nurse.

The district is asking that families continue to complete daily at home monitoring of children prior to them coming to school. It is of the utmost importance that these steps be completed.
