Good Afternoon,

Over the last 48 hours the Union Local School District has had three new cases of COVID. Two cases are in students at Union Local Middle School. One case is in a student at Union Local High School. Union Local District has six active cases of COVID at Union Local Elementary. Nine active cases of COVID exist at Union Local Middle School. Union Local High School has four active cases.

Families are asked to report any positive cases of COVID within their child to their respective child's school nurse. Also, if the child may have been considered a close contact of someone with a positive case this should be reported to the school nurse.

<u>The district is asking that families continue to complete daily at home monitoring of</u> children prior to them coming to school. It is of the utmost importance that these steps be completed.

Families should not send a child to school if any of the above symptoms are present in a student. Families should seek guidance from their child's respective school in return to school protocol. This can be obtained by speaking with the building nurse.
