Good Afternoon,

The Union Local School District has four new confirmed cases of COVID. One case at Union Local Elementary School in a staff member. Two cases at Union Local Middle School, one in a staff and one in a student. Union Local High School has one new case of COVID in a staff member. Contact tracing has been completed with these current cases. The Union Local District has sixteen active cases of COVID at Union Local Elementary. Seven active cases of COVID exist at Union Local Middle School. Union Local High School has two active cases. Families are asked to report any positive cases of COVID within their child to their respective child's school nurse. Also, if the child may have been considered a close contact of someone with a positive case this should be reported to the school nurse.

The district is asking that families continue to complete daily at home monitoring of children prior to them coming to school. It is of the utmost importance that these steps be completed

DAILY AT HOME SYMPTOM MONITORING	
Morning Temperature:	
Fever or Chills	New loss of taste or smell
Headache	Sore Throat
Cough	Congestion or runny nose
Shortness of Breath or Difficulty Breathing	Nausea or vomiting
Fatigue	Diarrhea
Muscle or Body Aches	Exposure to a positive COVID case
Families should not send a child to school if any of the above symptoms are present in a student. Families should seek guidance from their	
child's respective school in return to school protocol. This can be obtained by speaking with the building nurse.
