Here are some updates:

- The school building remains closed until further notice. As a precaution we have closed our building and playground for extra cleaning. This week our cleaning staff will continue to thoroughly disinfect and clean all classrooms, common areas, offices and surfaces.
- Students in need of breakfast and lunch. Our student meals will continue in the same way as last week. Meal pick-up will be on Sunday from 11:00 a.m.—2:00 p.m. in the same location, outside the loading area of the cafeteria.   about your families and remaining healthy. As educators we are discussing these topics daily
  among the local superintendents, with BOCES colleagues, and also at the state level. We are
