

Dress & Appearance For Graduation

Graduation is a semi-formal extra-curricular activity, which will be viewed by over one thousand parents, relatives, and friends. This activity will also be video taped. We encourage you to participate in the Graduation Ceremony; however, you are not required to do so.

If you do not wish to attend graduation, you must submit a signed statement (with parent signature) to the class adviser, Mr. Masterson Booth, stating your intentions by May 14.

As this is a formal event, the following guidelines apply in order to participate in the Graduation Ceremony:

Men:

Dress Shirt (white if possible), Tie (preferred)
Dark Color Dress Slacks (no jeans of any kind)
Dark Color Socks
Dark Color Dress Shoes (no athletic shoes, sandals, boots or flip flops)
No Sunglasses

Women:

Dress
Dress Slacks (no jeans of any kind) and blouse
Dress Shoes (no athletic shoes, boots or flip-flops)
No Sunglasses

Caps may **NOT** be decorated

All school policies apply on the day of Graduation practice and during Graduation Ceremonies. Your cooperation will be appreciated in order to best present the Class of 2025.
