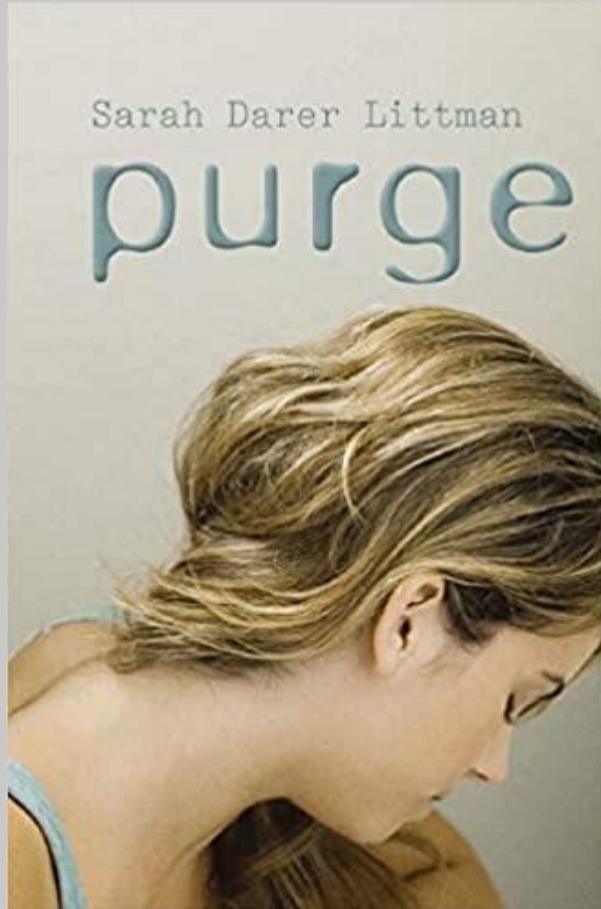
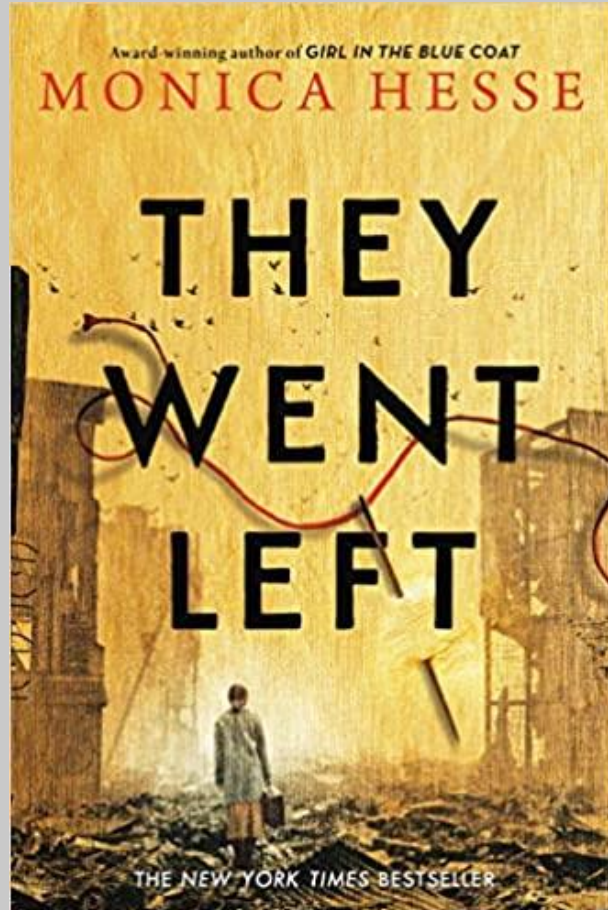


# PURGE



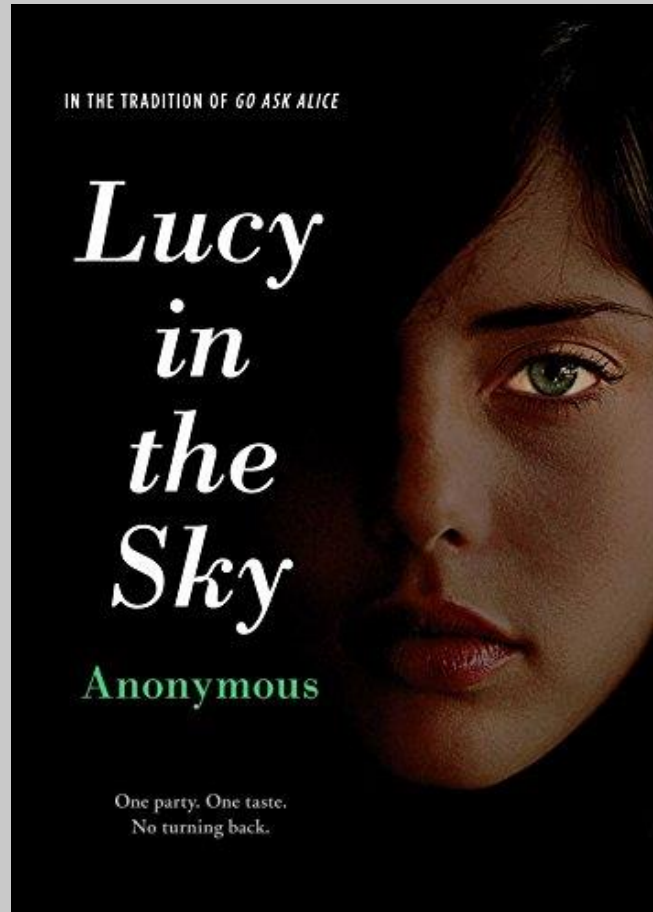

# THEY WENT LEFT (HOLOCAUST)



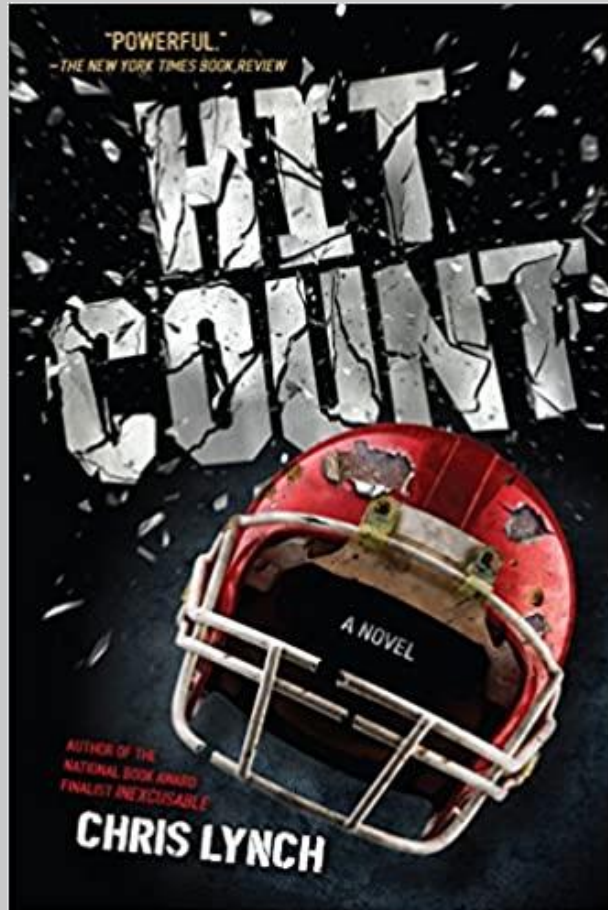

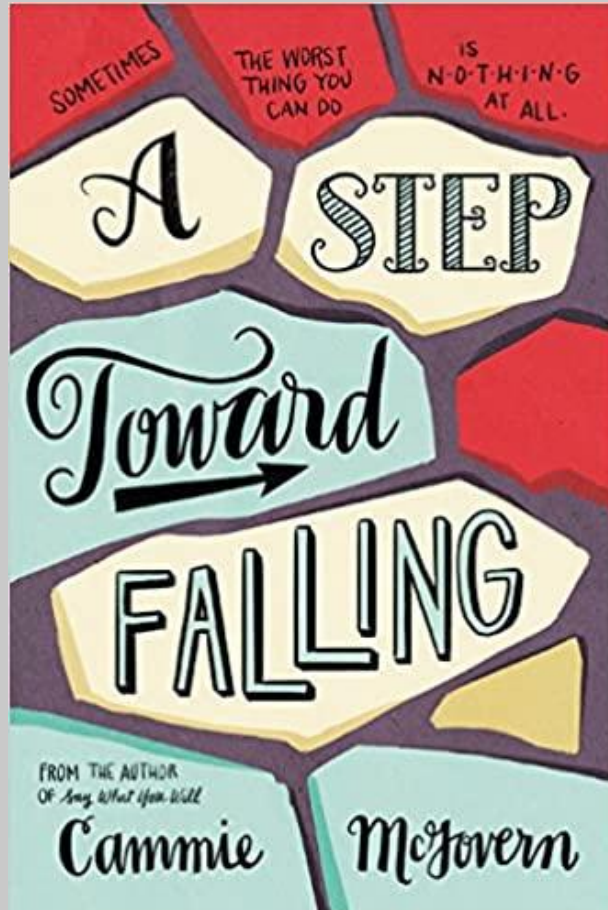
# THE FORGETTING



- Georgie awakens after a heart transplant to find her memories mixed with those of her donor, pushing her to solve a murder and save others involved.

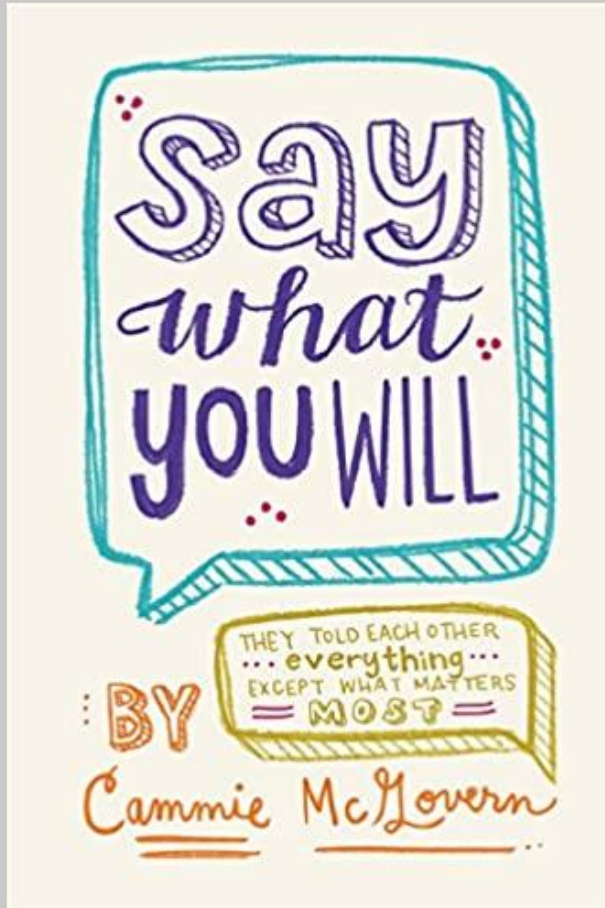


# STEP TOWARD FALLING



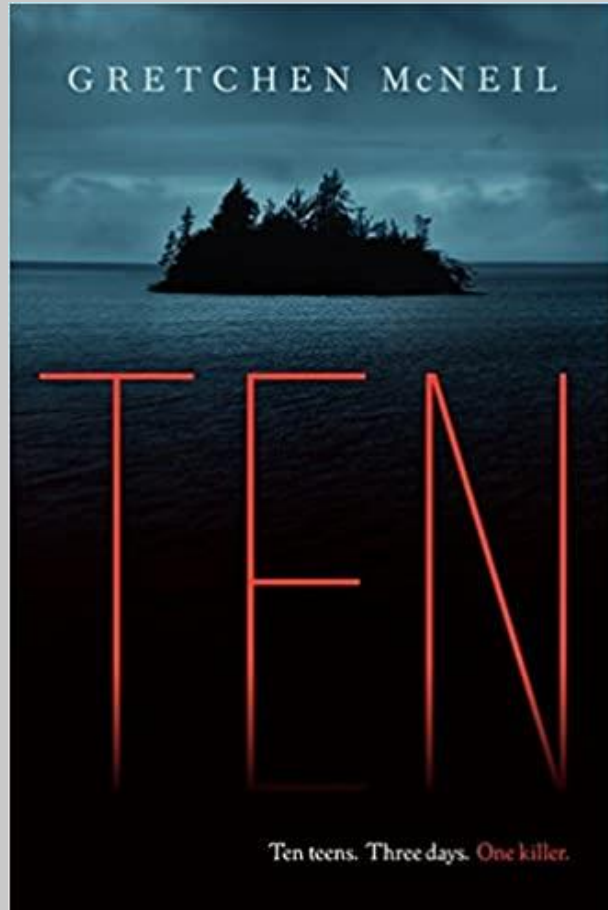

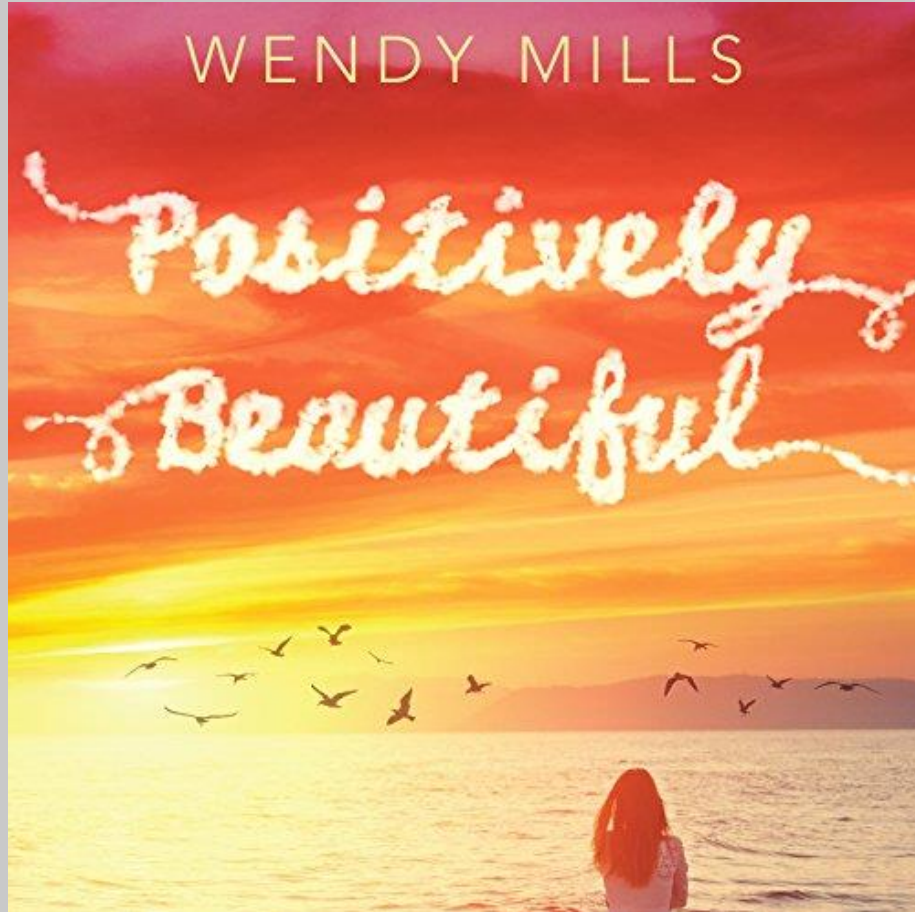
# TEN

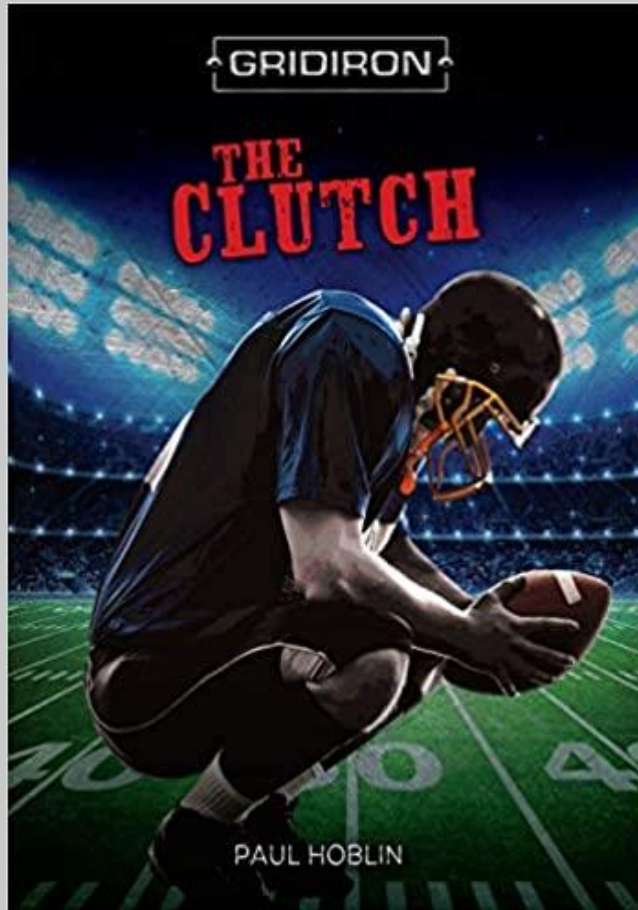


# POSITIVELY BEAUTIFUL
