



Instructions To Get Started (For Fall Coaches Start Course March 31st):

1. First time users - register on CTC's website <https://coachestoolchest.com/> by clicking on the "Start Here" button as pictured below

2. Once registered, click on the get certified button as pictured here to complete the training/assessments.



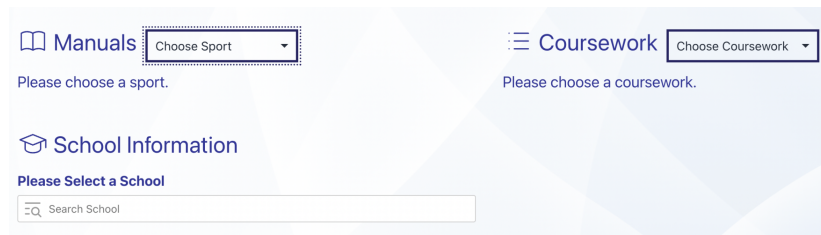

3. Once completed, download your certificate and send it to the athletic office or upload to your school coaches account (ex. Final Forms, Big Teams, rschool today account)

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. What is Coaches' Tool Chest (CTC)?
 - CTC is a web based certification program fully approved in the State of Ohio by the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) and the Ohio Department of Education (ODE) to provide athletic coaches with one location to complete all athletic coaching certification requirements including First Aid, CPR, Sudden Cardiac / Lindsay's Law, Fundamentals of Coaching (if needed) and starting in March 2023 - newly required PBIS.
2. What is the cost of CTC?
 - \$49/year per coach. We do offer discounts if schools choose to buy subscription codes in bulk. For more information on bulk pricing see contact information below.
3. Why would a veteran coach take an annual course when the old method is good for more than one year or a coach can do a course or 2 at no charge?
 - Simply put - your most valuable resource is your time!
 - Under the old method you could spend hours sitting in different courses or searching the internet for programs that are accepted/required and at the end of the day those courses provide the same information, year after year and you really are not learning anything.
 - Our course offers a coach the ability to get refreshed information, updated and current topics that provide real life strategies.

4. Why are over 400 school districts in the State of Ohio using CTC?

5. How long does CTC certification take?
 - For most coaches, it will take about 60-90 minutes to complete.
6. How long is the certification good for?
 - The certification is good from the time of completion until June 30th of the school year for which the certification was completed. The platform rolls over to the following year on March 31st (so March 31, 2023 the course is good through June 30, 2024).
7. Once I complete the test, is there anything else I need to do?
 - Coaches must still maintain a valid PAP.
 - Coaches must still maintain valid fingerprinting with the district.
8. Will I still need to apply/renew my PAP?
 - Yes, CTC provides the coursework to then apply for your Pupil Activity Permit as needed (every 3 or 5 years).
9. Will I still need to get fingerprinted?
 - Yes, coaches must still get fingerprinted when required to obtain PAP.
10. What else does the platform do other than certify coaches?
 - Gives coaches access to AED locations for other schools
 - Emergency response and contact information by school
 - OHSAA sport specific handbook/bylaw reference information (searchable)
