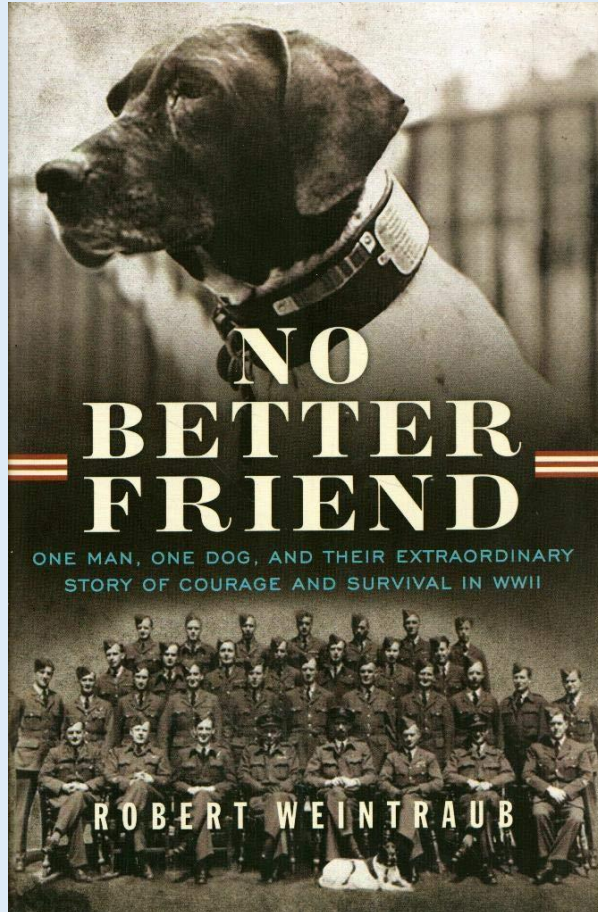

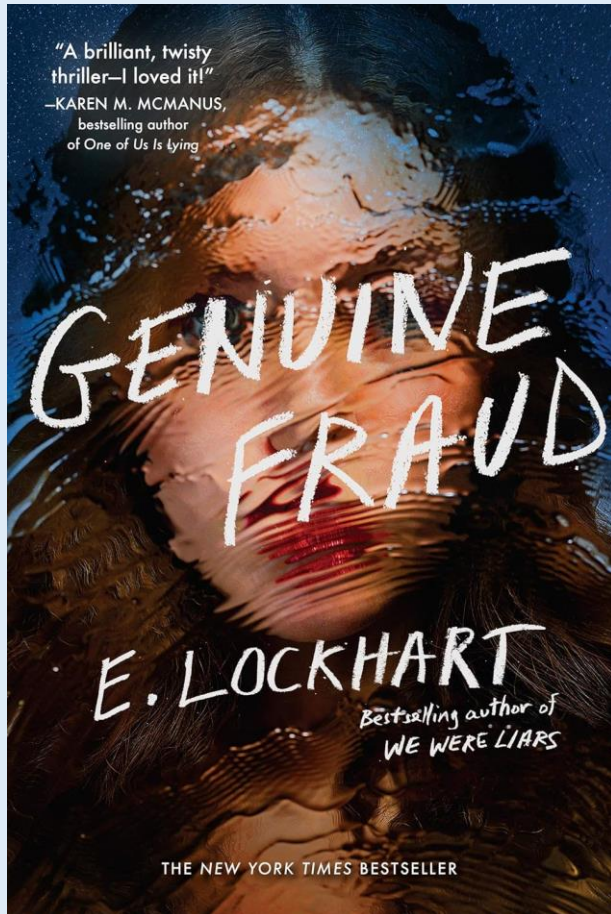

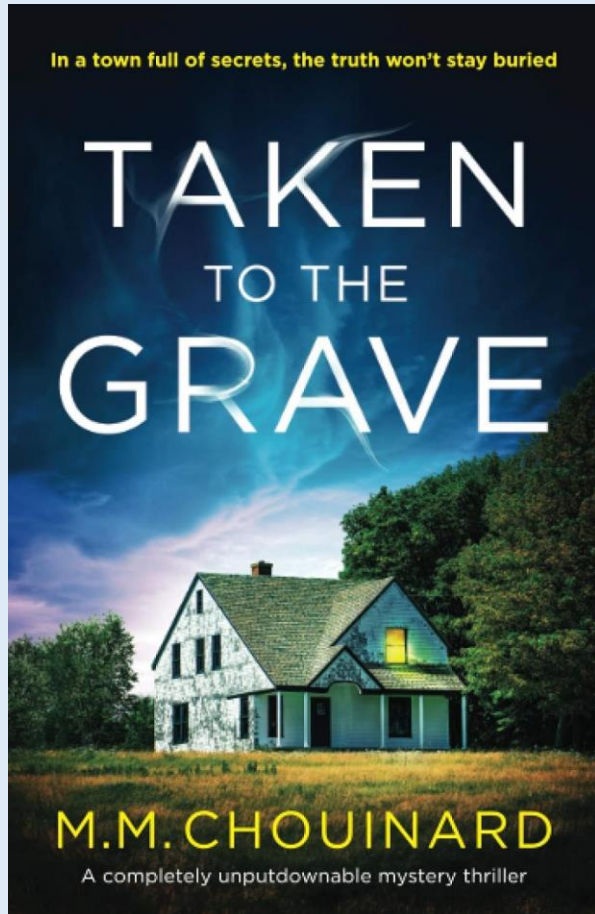


Told through flashbacks, best friends Julie and Imogen are orphaned outcasts who will do almost anything to attain a happy wealthy life.

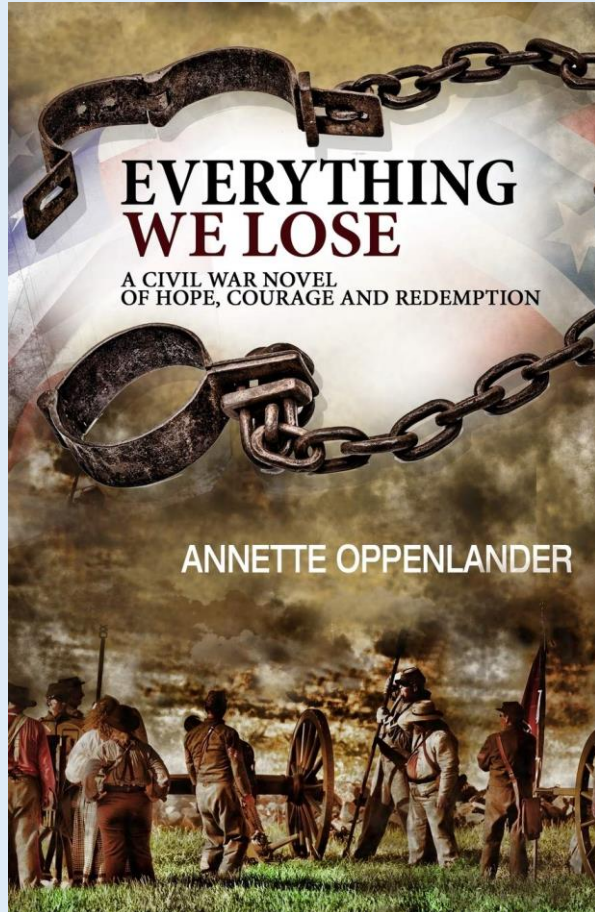

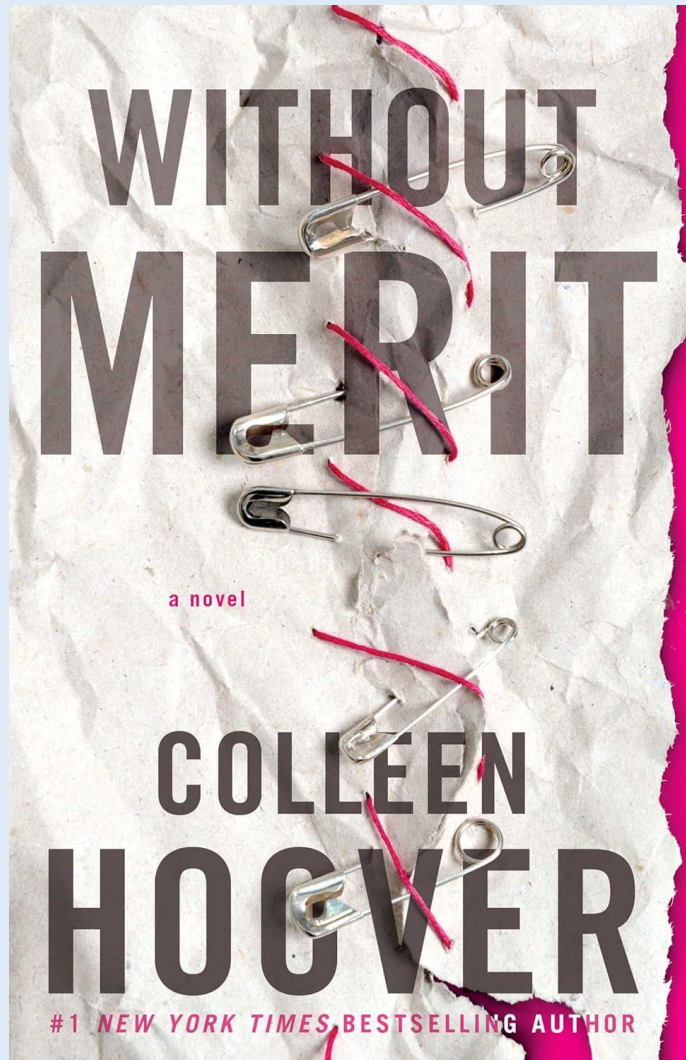

WITHOUT MERIT

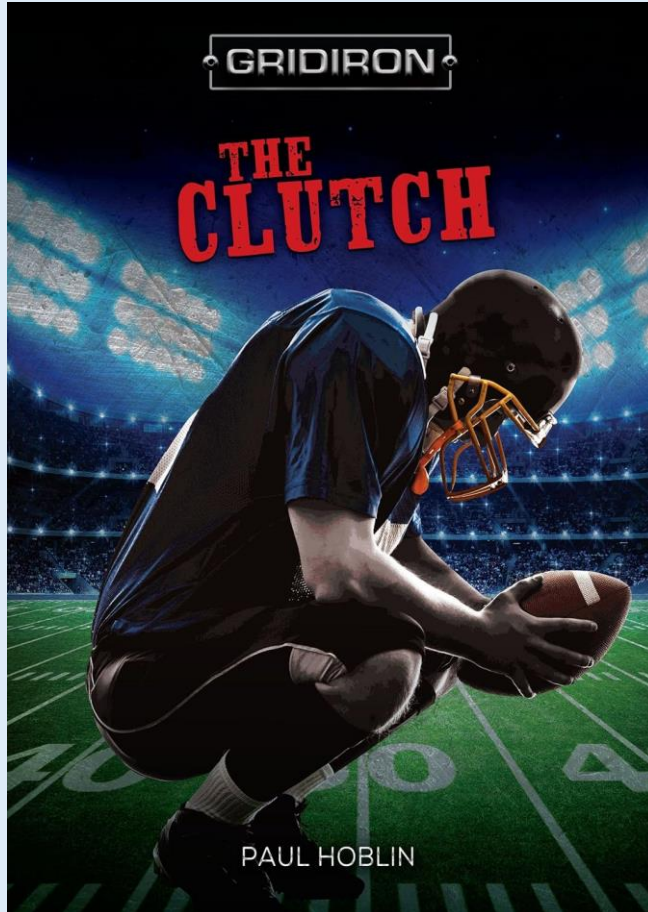

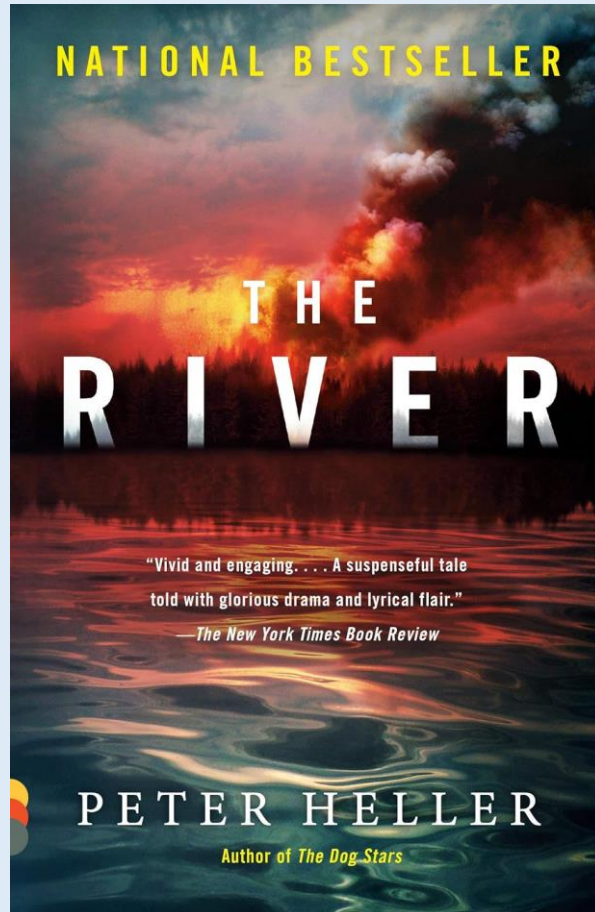

THE RIVER



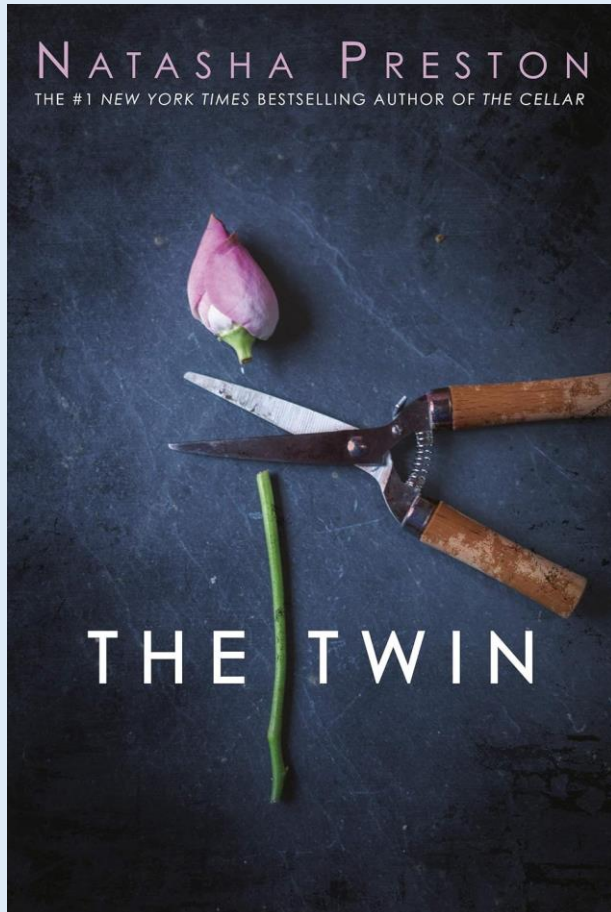

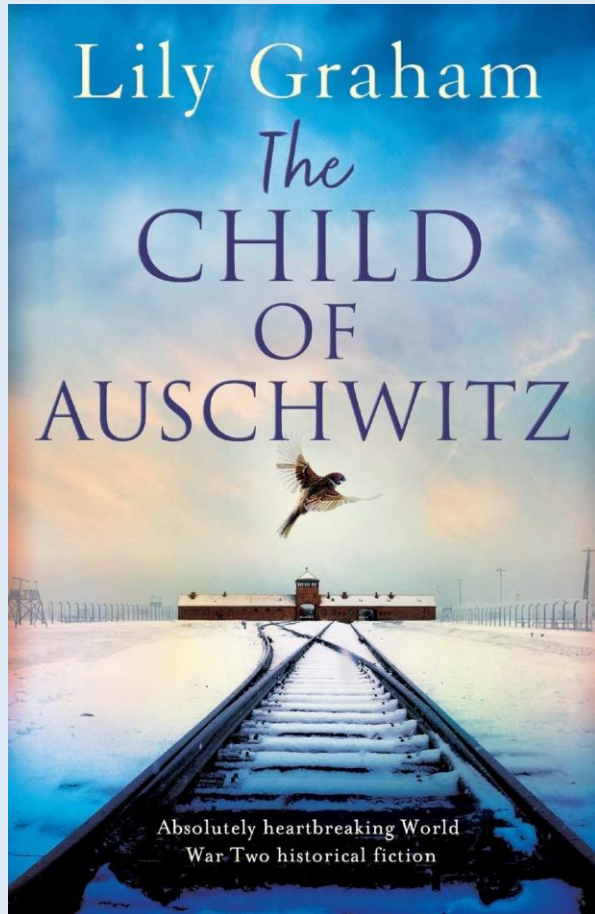

THE TWIN



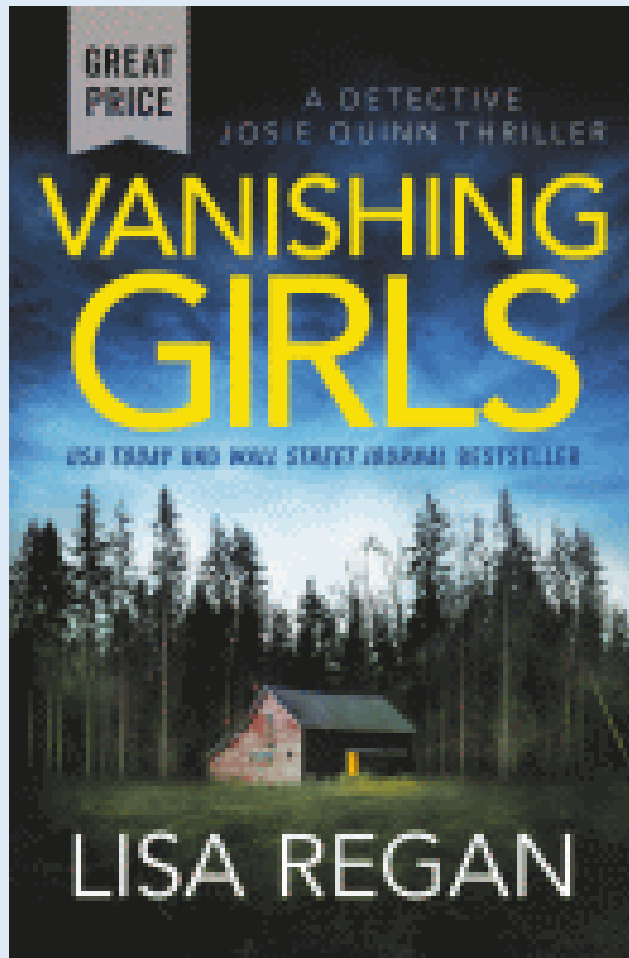
- After Ivy's twin sister, Iris, moves in with her and their father, Ivy learns Iris is trying to push her out of her life and may be responsible for their mother's death.

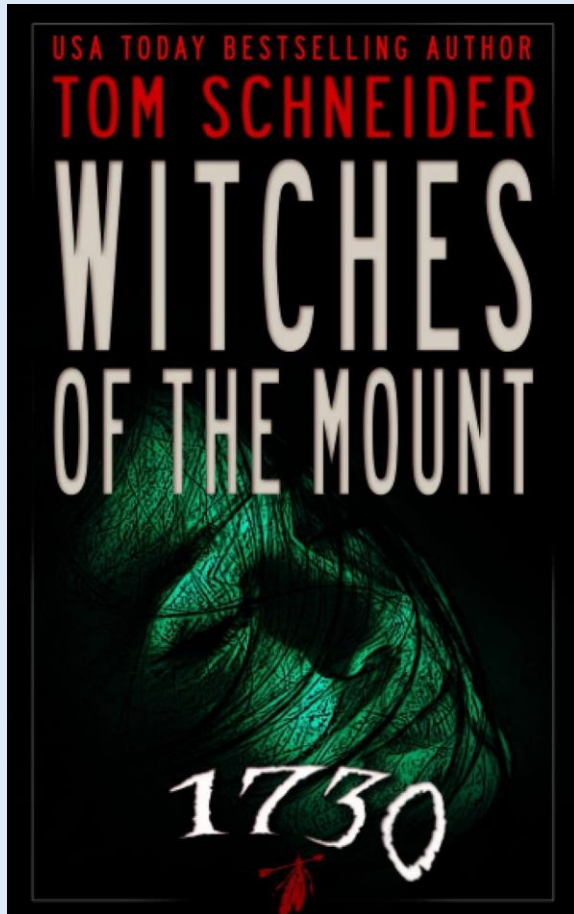

VANISHING GIRLS



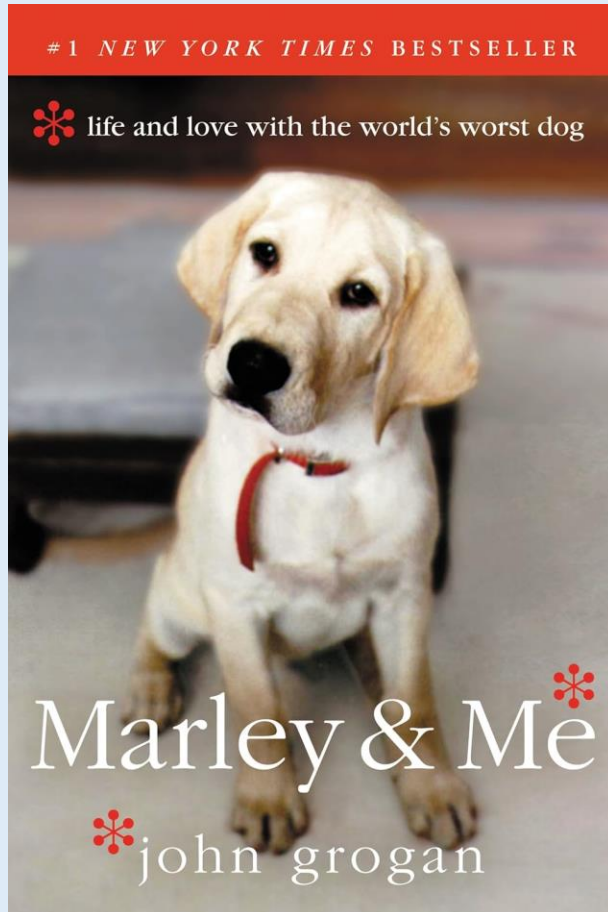

WITCHES OF THE MOUNT 1730



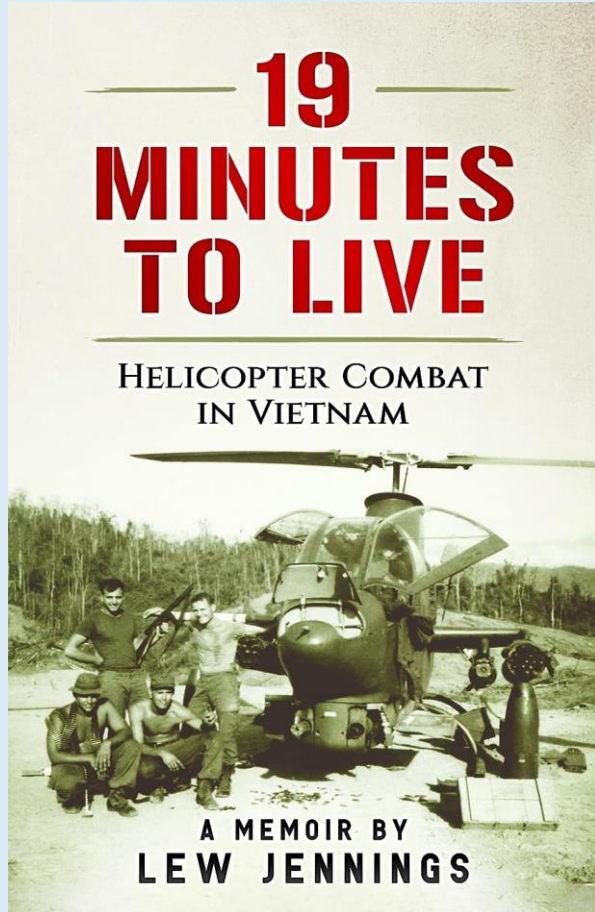

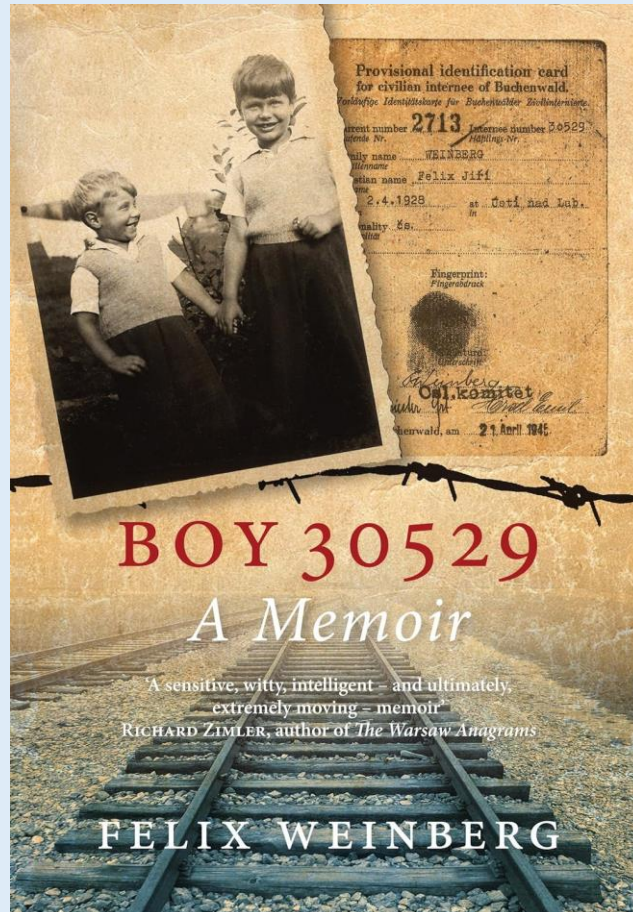
