
 Michael Bornstein, who at age four was one of the youngest children to be liberated from Auschwitz, shares the incredible story of his life, his family, and his Polish village.

• Provides dozens of eyewitness accounts of the events of 9/11, not analyzing the political events of the time, but rather the street-level reactions of average people. Includes photographs.






 A young Jewish pianist at Auschwitz, desperate to save her family, is chosen to play at the camp commandant's house. How could she know she would fall in love with the wrong boy




