High School Credit Recovery Program 2023

Students in grades 9-12 at risk of failing a course are eligible to stay after school on Tuesdays and Wednesdays for 1 hour to complete a “grade improvement program”. The program will start on Tuesday April 4 and end on Wednesday May 10, 2023. Sessions will start at 2:50pm and end promptly at 3:50pm.

Fairfield Union teachers will provide educational support for students during this program. Participating students will be assigned coursework to “make-up” or improve previous assignments from earlier in the school year. Students will have the opportunity to raise a failing grade in any one nine-week grading period by a maximum of 1 letter grade.

To participate in this program, parents will need to complete this form and return it to the office. Please note that transportation will not be provided for this program.
