

Community joins RMS students in remembering those killed on 9/11

On September 13, 2022 families and community members joined Rushville Middle School Students for their first 9/11 Memorial Showcase. Students spent the weeks leading up to the event creating projects honoring those killed 22 years ago in New York City, Washington DC, and Shanksville, PA. Visitors were able to walk through the hallways and view the memorial installation consisting of 2,977 names, informational one pagers, poetry, art projects, and staff interviews of where they were on 9/11. More than 300 friends and family attended the event.

Marching Falcons to perform at Fairfield County Fair




