Details:

- 1 flat=\$20.00 (no half flats this year)
- There are 8 pints to a flat.
- Phone, email, and orders given to FCCLA members (using order form) will be taken from January 27-February 12, 2020.
- Online orders may be placed through the end of the day on February 14, 2020.
- Extras flats will not be ordered so make sure you order what you want during the sale dates.
- Delivery will be the week of March 2, 2020. Specific date will be determined later.
- Anyone who orders on-line will be notified of the delivery date either by the student you purchased from, email, or phone.
- Pick-up location is outside the FCS classrooms on the east side of the high school near the soccer/biddy football practice fields between the hours of 2:00 pm and 4:30 pm or other arrangements need to be made at the time of ordering.
- If ordering directly through Mrs. McClure-Spillers, payment is due upon pick-up in the form of cash or check.
