Pg. 1-2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Have you ever received gifts for a special holiday or event? What was it?• Tell me about a time when you have written or used a list. What was on it?
Pg. 3-4	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• What do you notice about the party? What is everyone wearing?• Have you ever been to a party? What did you wear? What did you do at the party?
Pg. 5-6	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• What is your favorite part about a party? What about games, ice cream, and presents?• If you could throw a party today, what would your party have? What would you be celebrating at your party?
Pg. 7-8	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Have you ever written a letter? What about a thank you letter?• What is something for which you would like to say “thank you?”• Look at the names on these letters. What do you call your grandparents, cousins, or friends? Do you use their names or nicknames?
Pg. 9-10	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• What do you notice about these letters? What is something Grace writes in each of the letters?• If you wrote a letter, who would it be for? What would it say?
