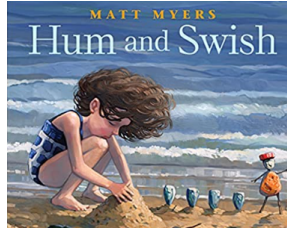

Pg. 1-2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● What does it mean to be friends?</li> <li>● In what ways do you think Jamie and the sea will be friends?</li> <li>● What does it mean to hum? Show us. How does a swish sound?</li> </ul>
Pg. 3-4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● What kind of questions do you think the people coming and going will ask?</li> <li>● What would you ask Jamie?</li> <li>● What do you notice about what Jamie is creating?</li> </ul>
Pg. 5-6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● What kind of things could you find on the beach to create, like Jamie is?</li> <li>● Have you ever been to the beach? What was it like? Who was there?</li> </ul>

Pg. 9-10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Can you think of something pretty? What was it? Tell us about it.</li> <li>● Do you think what Jamie is making is pretty? Why or why not?</li> </ul>
Pg. 11-12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Look at Jamie's creation now. What do you notice? Tell us about it.</li> <li>● What would you call what Jamie is making? How would you answer this kiddo's question?</li> </ul>
Pg. 13-14	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Take a look at Jamie's face. How do you think Jamie is feeling?</li> <li>● What do you think is bothering Jamie?</li> </ul>
Pg. 15-16	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Imagine you are on a beach. What sounds do you hear?</li> <li>● What would you do if you were on this beach with Jamie?</li> <li>● How do you think the swishing waves make Jamie feel?</li> </ul>
Pg. 17-18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Can you remember what questions the people on the beach asked?</li> <li>● What stories do you think the sea would tell, if the sea could talk?</li> </ul>

Pg. 27-28	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What do you think the new person at the beach is making?</li> <li>• If you had these tools (paint, canvas, easel) what would you make?</li> </ul>

Pg. 31-32	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What makes you think Jamie, the sea and the woman are friends?</li> <li>• What do you notice? Are they talking a lot or working quietly next to each other? Why?</li> </ul>
Pg. 33-34	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What do you notice about Jamie humming? When does she hum the most?</li> <li>• What else swishes in the story?</li> </ul>
Pg. 35-36	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Look at Jamie's creation now that it is done. What do you see? What do you think it is?</li> <li>• What are some of the things from the story you notice in the creation? (the sunblock, juicebox, shells)</li> </ul>
