Class creates a Flat Stanley




Students compose questions they would like answered about the region Flat Stanley is traveling to.



Mail/Receive Flat Stanley and questions to/from partner class.



Students take their new flat friend on different adventures near their school, around their community and record Stanley's adventures using pictures and/or videos.
