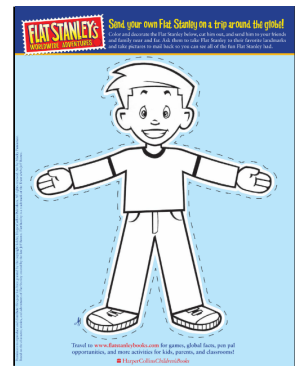
Available to school districts that participate in a NYS Distance Learning BOCES Service.

What happens when a normal boy finds himself flattened by a bulletin board and is sent through the mail to places all across the state? Your students can find out during this project, based on the 1964 book written by Jeff Brown. Classes across New York State will participate in this project and send their Flat Stanley around the state to visit a different classroom and community. Two classrooms will be paired for each session.

- 1** Read Flat Stanley by Jeff Brown.
- 2** Class creates a Flat Stanley
- 3** Students compose questions they would like answered about the region Flat Stanley is traveling to.
- 4** Mail/Receive Flat Stanley and questions to/from partner class.
- 5** Students take their new flat friend on different adventures near their school, around their community and record Stanley's adventures using pictures and/or videos.
- 6** At the end of each journey, partner schools will videoconference to meet one another, discuss their hometown and experiences with their flat friends.
