It is the Vendors' responsibility to read the following General Conditions, and the attached Detailed Instructions, Specifications and Bid which outline the bidding rules of the Otsego Northern Catskills BOCES.

Where the terms "bid" or "bids" are used in these documents, the bidder understands that the terms "proposal" or "proposals" could be used to replace "bid" or "bids" and be used interchangeably depending on the scope and nature of this solicitation.

DEFINITIONS

"BOCES"	The legal designation of the BOCES issuing this bid request.	

"Notice to Bidders" A formal statement which, when issued by the BOCES, constitutes a

Solicitation for Bids on the commodity, product, and/or services described

"Board" The Board of Education of the BOCES.

"Bid" An offer to furnish commodities, products, and/or services in accordance

with the Notice to Bidders, the General Conditions, Detailed Instructions,

- 3. All Bids received after the time stated in the Notice to Bidders will not be considered and will be returned unopened to the Vendor. The Vendor assumes the risk of any delay in the mail or in the handling of the mail by employees of the Otsego Northern Catskills BOCES. Whether sent by mail or by means of personal delivery, the Vendor assumes responsibility for having the Bid deposited on time at the place specified.
- 4. All information required by the Notice to Bidders, General Conditions, Special Conditions, Instructions, Contract Specifications, and Bid, in connection with each item against which a Bid is submitted, must be given to constitute a regular Bid.
- 5. The Non-Collusive Bidding Certification must be included with each Bid as required by General Municipal Law, section 103-d.
- 6. The submission of a Bid will be construed to mean the Vendor is fully informed as to the extent and character of the commodity, product, and/or services required and a representation that the Vendor can furnish the commodity, product, and/or services satisfactorily in complete compliance with the Specifications.
- 7. No alteration, erasure, or addition is to be made in the typewritten or printed matter. Deviations from the Specifications must be set forth in space provided in the Bid for this purpose.
- 8. Rates and information required should be typewritten for legibility. Illegible or vague Bids may be rejected. All signatures must be written. Facsimile, printed, or typewritten signatures are not acceptable.
- 9. The quantities for each Bid are indefinite, but estimates given in the Specifications reflect anticipated requirements. The Contract, however, shall be for the quantities actually ordered during the contract period. The Contractor must furnish all the quantities actually ordered.
- 10. Sales to the Otsego Northern Catskills BOCES are not affected by any fair trade agreements (General Business Law, sec. 369).
- 11. No charge will be allowed for Federal, State, or municipal sales and excise taxes since the Otsego Northern Catskills BOCES is exempt from such taxes. The rate shall be net and shall not include the amount of any such tax.

- 12. In all Specifications, the words "or equal" are understood after each article, or on any patented article. The decision of the Otsego Northern Catskills BOCES as to whether an alternate or substitution is in fact "equal" shall be final. If Bids are submitted on items other than those specified, the Vendor must in every instance give the trade designation of the article, manufacturer's name, and detailed specifications of the item proposed to furnish. Otherwise, the Bid will be construed as submitted on the identical item as specified.
- 13. When Bids are requested on a lump sum basis, the Vendor must complete each item in the lump sum group. A Vendor desiring to submit a "no charge" on an item in a group must so indicate; otherwise, the entire Bid for the group may be rejected.
- 15. All Bids must be sealed. Plain, opaque envelopes must be used, clearly marked "Bid" with the corresponding Bid number. AWARD

- 17. Awards will be made to the responsible qualified Vendor offering the highest discount rate, favorable contract term, and highest savings to the BOCES.
- 18. The Otsego Northern Catskills BOCES reserves the right to reject all Bids. Also reserved is the right to reject, for cause, any Bid in whole or in part; to waive technical defects; qualifications, irregularities; and omissions if in its judgment the best interests of the Otsego Northern Catskills BOCES will be served. Also reserved is the right to reject Bids and to purchase items on State or County Contracts if such items can be obtained on the same terms, conditions, specifications, and at a higher discount rate.
- 19. The Otsego Northern Catskills BOCES reserves the right to make Awards within 30 days after the date of the Bid opening during which period Bids may not be withdrawn unless the Vendor distinctly states in the Bid that acceptance thereof must be made within a shorter specified time.
- 20. Each Bid will be received with the understanding that the acceptance thereof in writing by the Board, to furnish any or all of the commodity, product, and/or services described therein shall constitute a Contract between the Successful Vendor and the Otsego

- Northern Catskills BOCES. This Contract shall bind the Successful Vendor to furnish and deliver at the rates and in accordance with the conditions of the Bid.
- 21. Vendors should ensure accuracy in figures **prior to** submission. If a Vendor discovers a mistake in an item in their Bid award and wants that item award rescinded after it has been Awarded, the Otsego Northern Catskills BOCES reserves the right to rescind the entire award and the Vendor's responsibility may be questioned for future Bids.
- 22. The submission of a Notice of Award to a Successful Vendor, to the address given in the Bid, will be considered sufficient notice of acceptance of bid.
- 23. Any and all Awards resulting from this Bid shall be final and shall be for the complete term of the Contract. No rescinding of Awards will be made because of Vendor error or inability to supply a commodity, product, and/or service.
- 24. The Successful Vendor is responsible for reviewing the Notice of Award for errors. Any clerical errors in the Award must be forwarded, in writing, to Bruce Capron, Assistant Superintendent for Business and Operations within five (5) working days of the Notification of Award. No corrections will be made beyond that date. If clerical errors are discovered too late to be corrected, a "no award" will be issued on those affected commodity, product, and/or services. The commodity, product, and/or services will be rebid or quoted at a later date.
- 25. A Contract may be canceled at the Successful Vendor's expense upon non-performance of Contract.
- 26. Cancellation of Contract for any reason may result in removal of the Successful Vendor's name from mailing list for future Bids for an indefinite period.

31. The Successful Vendor shall not be held responsible for any losses resulting if the fulfillment of the terms of the Contract shall be delayed or prevented by wars, acts of public enemies, strikes, fires, floods, or acts of God.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

The Successful Vendor will sell solar energy credits under the NYSERDA/NY-Sun Community Solar (Community Distributed Generation) Program and/or any related project including Remote Crediting to the BOCES on the terms set forth in its bid, as follows:

Analyze: Successful Vendor will perform an analysis of the BOCES' utility bills to determine and identify (i) average estimated savings; and (ii) a minimum guaranteed savings resulting from energy credits.
