# Graduation Requirements

- Posted on guidance website.
- #1 Course Requirements
  - 21 credits in specific subject areas.
- #2 Competency Requirements
  - 684 on Algebra I and ELA II.
- #3 Readiness Requirements
  - 2 diploma seals (1 must be state issued)
    - Fine art, Biology, Government, OMJ

# Competency Requirements

- If students do not earn a competent score in ELA II and/or Algebra I after initial attempt/retake, they must meet one of the following alternative pathways:
  - Earn college credit in that subject area (placement test required); OR
  - Commit to a branch of the armed forces; OR
  - \*Show career readiness through a program at Tri Rivers Career Center.

# Honors Diploma

- Recognition at graduation.

# Other Graduation Honors

- Honors Student-Cumulative GPA 3.5 and above.
- Fine Arts Cord-4 years of Art, Band, or Choir (no combination) plus participation in music activities or other art classes.
- Student Government Cord-3 years on student council.
- Athletic Cord-participation in two sports for three years.
- Community Service Cord-40 hours of community service and a GPA of 2.5 or above.

# Options for Next Year

- Full-time at Pleasant with regular high school classes.
- Full-time at Pleasant with a mix of high school and college credit plus classes.
- Part-time at Pleasant with college classes scheduled outside of Pleasant (online or on campus).
- Full-time at Tri Rivers Career Center.
- Part-time at Tri Rivers Career Center.
  - Must provide your own transportation; academic schedule may not work; accepted last.

# Things to Consider

- Future plans-Career tech or college bound?
  - Employment, enlistment, enrollment
- Are you planning to take CCP?
  - In what capacity? At PHS? On college campus?
  - Do you qualify? Applied to the college?
  - Have you attended a meeting? Signed the letter of intent?
- Are you planning to attend Tri Rivers?
  - Have you applied online?
- State wants graduates to have 12 CCP hours or 12 industry credentials or military bound.

# TRCC Admissions

- Tri Rivers-2<sup>nd</sup> round online applications due Feb 16th.
- First round applications (due January 1<sup>st</sup>) will be notified of acceptance/rejection soon.
- Vet Science, Engineering, Health Career Academy, Exercise Science-CCP credit (must complete Letter of Intent and apply to MTC)
- **If your ELA II or Algebra I test score is below 684, you must apply to TRCC to meet the alternate pathway to graduate.**

# CCP Part-time vs. Full-time

- Many juniors will be @ Pleasant all day.
  - 7 HS classes and 1 HS or 8 HS classes
- If you have not taken Algebra II, Chemistry I, and a third year of foreign language, or your GPA is below a 3.2, doing part-time Pleasant/part-time CCP is not recommended.
- Poor CCP performance junior year will eliminate opportunities for senior year.

# How to use CCP

- General education credits.
  - English, Math, Science, History, Intro to Psychology, Oral Communication, Ethnic & Cultural Diversity
- Explore career options.
- Meet requirements for a degree.
- Meet requirements to apply for a major.
  - i.e. Healthcare, engineering, etc.

# Part-time CCP Students

- Schedule junior courses as normal.
  - 7 minimum credits-each 3, 4 or 5 hour CCP class are considered 2 credits towards this total.
  - HS classes count as 1 credit towards this total.
  - May have to be at Pleasant past lunch.
- Our classes take priority!
- You are responsible for setting up advising appointment with a college advisor for any CCP section not offered at Pleasant.
  - Taylor Wright will be at PHS in Spring to schedule students for Fall MTC classes. Due May 8, 2026

# Part-time CCP Advice

- Maximize your 30 semester hours.
  - Class rank will suffer with fewer classes.
  - College look at schedules for rigor and full class load.
- Schedule on campus, not online (if possible).  
Get a better college experience.
- If the CCP class is offered at Pleasant, TAKE IT AT PLEASANT!!!!!!

  - *College ready score or all As/Bs in HS English*
- Algebra II, Introduction to College Math, *\*College Algebra, \*Trigonometry, \*Statistics, \*Quantitative Reasoning, \*Calculus I, \*Calculus II*
  - *\*CCP all taught in person*
- Integrated Science, Zoology, Chemistry I, Forensics, AP Physics, *\*Anatomy & Physiology I/II, \*Human Biology, \*Chemistry 1210 / 1260 (on MTC campus)*
  - *\*CCP all taught in person*

# Science and SS Electives

- Science Elective
  - Biomedical Science, Genetics of Disease (must first have Biomed Sci)
- Social Studies Electives
  - American History through Film (1 sem), Interactive History (1 sem), Geography, *\*Intro to Psychology, \*Lifespan Development, \*Social Psychology, \*Abnormal Psychology, \*Early or Modern American History*
  - \*CCP-all taught in person

# Foreign Language

- Spanish I, II, III, IV, CCP Spanish (schedule w/ MTC)
- French I, II, III , IV
- ASL is offered in person at MTC
- 4 year colleges prefer a minimum of 2 years of the same foreign language. Take 3 years, if possible. Language placement tests are common.
- Not required to graduate.
- C is required to move to next level.

- Can only have 1 SH unless approved through IEP/504.
- Choose 7 periods worth of classes if you want a study hall. Choose 8 periods worth of classes if you do not want a study hall.
  - Note some science classes have a lab/study hall period. Online CCP classes and Choir can be placed in alternating days.
