College Credit Plus Courses

College coursework will be granted 1.4 quality points. All college coursework (including CCP classes taken in middle school) are required by the State of Ohio to be included on the high school transcript.

Class Rank

Class rank will be determined by the cumulative number of quality points earned by a student. The number of quality points will change when credit is granted at the end of each semester.

Valedictorian/Salutatorian:

The student(s) with the highest number of quality points at the end of the 8th semester (regardless of GPA) AND completed requirements of the Ohio Academic Honors Diploma in the college preparatory curriculum will be deemed valedictorian.

The student with the next highest number of quality points (regardless of GPA) AND completed requirements of the Ohio Academic Honors Diploma in the college preparatory curriculum will be deemed salutatorian.

These students must be enrolled at Pleasant High School by the beginning of their junior year and complete 4 full semesters at Pleasant High School.

To Calculate Quality Points:

Three pieces of information are necessary to calculate the quality points for a course:

- Quality Point Rating for the specific course.
- Number of credits earned from the course.

Most HS courses are 0.5 credit per semester.

College Credit Plus courses ranging from 3-5 semester hours are equal to 1 HS credit.

College Credit Plus courses less than 3 semester hours will be the appropriate proportion of credit. Ex. 2 sem hrs = 0.667 credits.

Numerical grade value in the course. Ex. A=4, A-=3.667, B+ = 3.333, etc.

These three numbers are multiplied together to find the quality points earned for one course. Each course total added together equals the total number of quality points for the student.
