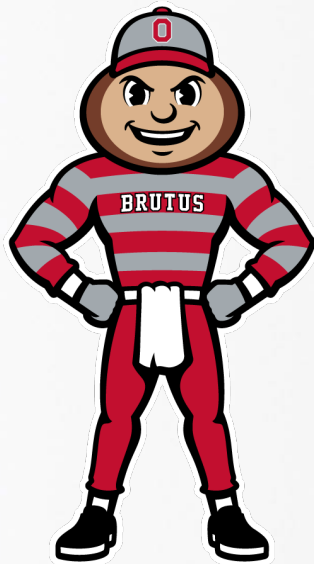

- Students can participate in the OSU Academy in Columbus or on any of our regional campuses
- Columbus and Regional Campuses have different requirements for admission
- Admission will be based upon a student's college readiness as measured by standardized test scores (ACT, SAT, or Accuplacer) or H.S GPA
- Students must meet the [College Readiness Standards](#) set by the state of Ohio.

Required Documents for OSU Academy Admission (All Campuses)



- High School Transcript
- School Information Form (pdf on application page)
- Mature Content Form
- Standardized test scores (ACT, SAT, or Accuplacer) (If necessary)
- Application and materials must be submitted by May 1, 2025

The Ohio State University- Marion



- Admission Criteria

Unweighted High School GPA of 3.0 or higher (4.0 scale) **and** 2 years of high school English and Math

- Students who do not meet this standard can be admitted by submitting standardized test scores that meet the Ohio College Readiness Standard:

ACT Scores: English- 18, Math - 22, Reading 22 **or**

SAT Scores: Evidence Based Reading and Writing - 480, Math - 530

- Accuplacer Information

Students who do not meet the test optional criteria, or the ACT/SAT score requirements may schedule an Accuplacer test with Enrollment Services at go.osu.edu/marionacademy once application is complete. There is no cost to the student. Ohio State will only accept scores taken at our testing center.

- Minimum ACCUPLACER scores required for admission:
 - Writing -263
 - Reading - 250
 - Math - 263

The Ohio State University- Columbus



- The Ohio State Academy at the Columbus campus follows the same competitive admission process as undergraduate admissions for new freshmen students
- Requires that students have earned 15 or more high school credits in the college preparatory curriculum (3 or more credits each in English, Math, Natural Science, Social Science and Foreign Language)
- Students with fewer overall credits have shown outstanding talent or advanced standing in an academic area

The Ohio State University- Columbus



- Strong High School Performance
 - 90% ranked in top 10% percent of their class
 - 90% had a cumulative GPA of 3.95 or higher *
 - *GPA can vary greatly by high school.
- Strong test scores
 - The middle 50% for ACT composite was 29-34
 - *Test Optional for Autumn 2025
