1. **Academic Achievement**

3. **Participation In School Activities**
4. **Participation In Out of School Activities**
5. **Community Involvement**

All of the following items must be attached to qualify for the PTO Scholarship:

1. **Application** - including name of student, address and signature of Parent or Legal Guardian.
2. **Essay** - must be typed on no more than one 8 ½ x 11-inch standard page of white paper.
3. **Transcript** - this does not have to be a notarized copy.
4. **Academic Teacher Reference** -Teacher of traditionally understood academia such as Math, Science, etc. Please use the attached Academic Reference Form. The form must be signed by the teacher.
5. **Teacher Reference** - Can be a teacher other than traditional academic teacher, such as a coach or music teacher. Please use the attached Teacher Reference Form and include signature.
6. **Outside Reference**- Please have the Outside Reference completed on standard size paper. It may be typed or handwritten but **MUST** be signed by the individual providing the reference.
