Our TCA students in grades 4 – 6 participated in the National Day of Learning on Monday, September 11, 2023. The day's activities included an introduction of the three attack sites and a more specific focus on the events that occurred in Shanksville, Pa. The Moment of Remembrance at the Flight 93 National Memorial was live streamed, as well as a live interaction in a question and answer session with the park rangers. The day concluded with a virtual tour of the Memorial.

On September 22, the Titan Cyber Academy visited the South Park Game Preserve. The TCA staff guided the students through the preserve, pointing out and discussing various animals and habitats, like the ducks and turtles in the pond, the peacock, and the main attraction, the South Park buffalo. It was a special day at the preserve for the buffalo. They received a weekly treat of fruits and vegetables. The students had the opportunity to witness the buffalo eating up close! There were even Park Rangers from Allegheny County on hand with displays of facts and items about the buffalo and other animals, including a real white wolf skin. 


We have kicked off the 2023 - 24 Pizza Hut Book It Reading program on October 1st.!
