Requesting College Credit Transcripts Class of 2022

Students who have taken **college credit classes** here at Pelham High School should be requesting official transcripts from the college(s) where they took the college credit classes. Directions and contact information for all of the colleges we are affiliated with are on the Pelham High School website under the College and Career Counseling Department [LINK](#). Please reach out to your counselor should you need additional assistance.

NOTE: If you are **currently enrolled** in a college credit course at PHS, please wait until the end of June/early July to request your college transcripts. Nashua, SNHU, and Manchester will not receive your grades until the end of the school year!

Retrieving your SAT Scores: Once your SAT scores are available online, you will receive an email to view them in your College Board Account. Should you have trouble logging in, **DO NOT** make another account. Contact the College and Career Counseling Department for assistance.



Requesting a VLACS Transcript: <https://go.vlacs.org>. Click the **Student Information System** -> **Request Transcript** link on the top. Click the **View Transcript** link on the left to request that VLACS mail an official transcript to Pelham High School
IMPORTANT NOTE: The student must request that their transcript(s) be sent to PHS in order to receive credit for their VLACS classes.

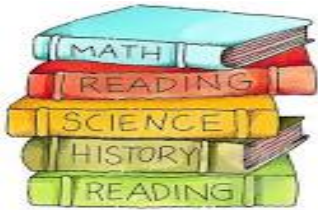

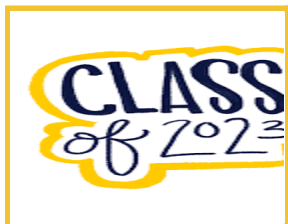


Math Help: Math help is now available Tuesday through Friday during Advisory 8:00-8:43 a.m. in room 114. All are welcome!
