#### **COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS INFORMATION**

## What is College Credit Plus?

College Credit Plus is Ohio's dual enrollment program that provides students in grades 7-12 the opportunity to earn college and high school credits at the same time by taking courses from Ohio colleges or universities. The purpose of this program is to enhance students' career readiness and postsecondary success, while providing a wide variety of options to college-ready students, at no or limited costs to students and families.

# **STEPS FOR COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS:**

## STEP 1

Please fill out the "Intent to Participate in College Credit Plus" form (attached) and turn it into Mrs. Eberhart (in HS office) by April 1, 2025. (Hard copies are in the guidance office.)

# STEP 2

Apply to OUE and/or Belmont College (you can apply to both).

**OUE** (must apply by June 1, 2025)

3. After filling out the application, there will be a page that the student will print out and give to Mrs. Eberhart to sign & send to OU. (College Credit Plus Application Signature Page–Hard copies are in the guidance office)

## **BELMONT** (must apply by June 27, 2025)

- 1. Apply here: <u>Belmont College CCP Application</u> or go to <u>http://www.belmontcollege.edu/</u> and Click Apply.
- 2. Click "College Credit Plus Application"
- 3. Complete the <u>Permission Form</u> and submit it. Please use the same email address that you used for your college applications. (Hard copies are available in the Guidance Office)

# STEP 3

Please let me know when you applied & I will send your transcript.

- \*OUE requires the Accuplacer Test to take lab science and math classes.
- \*Belmont College requires students to have an A/B in Algebra II to take a math class.
- \*HS students (current 9th-11th graders) must have a **3.0 cumulative High School GPA** to take college credit plus classes.
- \*ALL middle school students (current 6th-8th graders) must take the Accuplacer to take college credit plus classes. You must make arrangements with OUE and/or Belmont College to take the Accuplacer.

### **College Classes offered at ULHS**

Belmont College:

ENG 1110: Composition I (3 credit hours and 1 high school English credit)

ENG 1120: Composition II (3 credit hours and 1 high school English credit)

ENG 1150: Experiencing Literature (3 credit hours and 1 high school English credit)

COM 1115: Speech (3 credit hours and 1 high school English credit)

OUE.

SPAN 1110: Elementary Spanish I (4 credit hours and 1 high school Spanish credit)

SPAN 1120: Elementary Spanish II (4 credit hours and 1 high school Spanish credit)

Students must have their own transportation to take college classes at Belmont College and/or OUE. Students can take classes through both colleges during the same semester.

!!PLEASE KEEP IN MIND: If you withdraw from a class past the date to withdraw OR fail the course---you are responsible for payment to Union Local for that course. If your college credit plus GPA falls below a 2.0 or you withdraw from 2 courses in 1 semester, you will be placed on <u>probation</u> and can only take 1 course the following semester.!!

Also, keep in mind that colleges may have a different attendance policy than the high school. For example, field trips, fairs, assemblies, doctor appointments may not be excused at the college level.

These classes are taught for students 18 and older so some of the content/topics may not be appropriate for younger students.
