GRADUATION – 6/11 8PM

- Maintain tradition, accommodate for COVID, make great.
- Students will be provided an option to have graduation at:
 - The HS Student lot, with graduates on the hill, and families in the lot.
 - Capacity for guests (parking spaces): <u>932</u> (50 percent of 67 people /1000 sq foot)
 - Benefits: Preferred aesthetic, no fee to the district
 - Concerns: sound system, lighting, parking availability, setup and teardown, restroom availability.

 - Capacity for guests: <u>1400</u> (¹/₂ of the regular venue capacity)
